CERT

The CERT program helps train people to be better prepared to respond to emergency situations. At its core is the philosophy of neighbor helping neighbor.

Participants in the program are given the tools and training they need to help themselves, their families, neighborhoods and communities.

You do not need to join CERT in order to take the training; you, your family and your community will be the better just from your receiving the skills and knowledge from the training classes.

In 95% of all emergencies bystanders or victims themselves are the first to provide emergency assistance or to perform a rescue.
