## INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF Burlington, Iowa AND COUNTY OF Des Moines

### BJA FY 22 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program

This Agreement is made and entered into this **1st day of August 2022**, by and between The COUNTY of Des Moines acting by and through its governing body, the Board of Supervisors, hereinafter referred to as COUNTY, and the CITY of Burlington acting by and through its governing body, the City Council, hereinafter referred to as CITY, both of Des Moines County, State of Iowa, witnesseth:

WHEREAS, this Agreement is made under the authority of Sections 28E of the Code of Iowa: and

**WHEREAS**, each governing body, in performing governmental functions or in paying for the performance of governmental functions hereunder, shall make that performance or those payments from current revenues legally available to that party: and

**WHEREAS**, each governing body finds that the performance of this Agreement is in the best interests of both parties, that the undertaking will benefit the public, and that the division of costs fairly compensates the performing party for the services or functions under this agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the CITY and COUNTY believe it to be in their best interests to allocate the JAG funds.

### NOW THEREFORE, the COUNTY and CITY agree as follows:

### Section 1.

CITY and COUNTY agrees to spend up to \$20,363.00 for the purchase of active shooter response equipment accessible by CITY and COUNTY law enforcement personnel.

### Section 2.

Nothing in the performance of this Agreement shall impose any liability for claims against COUNTY other than claims for which liability may be imposed by the IOWA Tort Claims Act.

#### Section 3.

Nothing in the performance of this Agreement shall impose any liability for claims against CITY other than claims for which liability may be imposed by the IOWA Tort Claims Act.


