This meeting was also held electronically via Webex and YouTube live streaming. Public input was available through board email or call in.

Unless otherwise noted, all motions passed unanimously. The Pledge of Allegiance was conducted.

Meeting with Department Heads: County Auditor Sara Doty stated her office is preparing for the upcoming Primary Election. IT Director Colin Gerst stated his office is busy. Maintenance Director Rodney Bliesener reported his crew is busy. Land Use Administrator Zach James reported his office continues to be busy and he has an item on the agenda today. Sheriff Kevin Glendening reported the jail population is at 86. County Conservation Director Chris Lee reported his office is now functioning out of Starrs Cave Nature Center. Emergency Management Director Shannon Prado would like to remind the public to be prepared for the upcoming storms and to use Alert Iowa and the weather radio for the upcoming storms.
